

**English:**

- -ed suffix

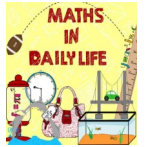


**Maths:**

Children will be learning addition and subtraction within 10.

Within this, they will be introduced to:

- Part-whole models
- Writing number sentences
- Number bonds within 10
- Addition and subtraction on a number line
- Taking away by crossing out, how many left?



The children will go onto learning about shape where they are introduced to 2-d and 3-d shapes.

They will learn their names and how to sort them according to their properties.

**History**

Within 'What is History?' children will be introduced to the discipline of history and the following areas:

- What is a Historian?
- What is an Archaeologist?
- How sources and evidence help uncover facts about the past. and offer reasons for this.
- Understand history is a story of the past.



**Art**

Children will focus on Drawing. They will study famous Artist William Hershel.

Creating their windmill children will be able to:

- Show control when using string and chalk to draw lines.
- Experiment with a range of mark-making techniques.
- Colour neatly and carefully.
- Apply a range of marks successfully to drawing
- Produce a drawing that displays observational skill.



**Science:**

Within 'What are the Materials we use?' children will learn about:

- Identify and name everyday materials
- Describe material properties
- Identify natural and man-made
- Predict and identify if objects will float or sink
- Identify which materials are best for different objects.

**PSHE:**

Through the Unit 'Celebrating Difference' children will take part in various activities and discussions covering the following learning:

- Identifying talents
- Being special
- Families
- Where we live
- Making friends
- Standing up for yourself



**Music:**

Within Music, children will be learning to:

- Use their voices expressively and creatively.
- Sing songs for a nativity.
- Play untuned percussion to a steady beat.



**PE:** Following our exciting new scheme, children will now develop their PE Skills across 2 units.

- Develop technique and control when jumping

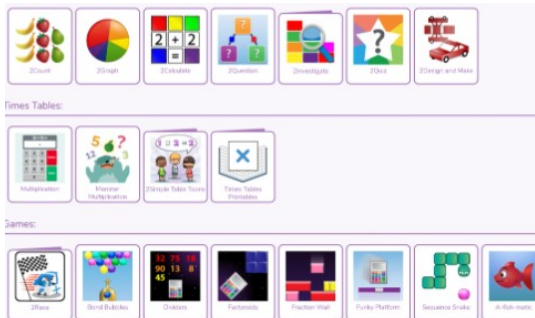
**Target Games**

Remember, children can log onto Purple Mash at home to get more familiar with the programme.



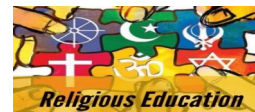
**Sikh Studies**
